ATTENTION DOG OWNERS

Again, complaints of dog barking, defecating on city, private and public property have been rolling in at city hall. Below you will find a copy of how the city ordinance reads regarding, "Animal Nuisances".

4-4 ANIMAL NUISANCES. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit an animal under such person's control or within such person's custody to commit a nuisance. An animal shall be considered a nuisance if it:

- 1. Damages, soils, defiles or defecates on private property other than the owner's or on public walks, and recreation areas unless such waste is immediately removed and properly disposed of by the owner.
- 2. Causes unsanitary, dangerous or offensive conditions.
- 3. Causes a disturbance by excessive barking or other noisemaking or chases vehicles, or molest, attacks or interferes with persons or other domestic animals on public property.

The fine for such a nuisance could be up to \$100.00. If you are out walking your dog please take a plastic bag with you to pick up any deposits your dog may leave. There has been an abundance of dog deposits in the city park and this is where our children play so please pick up after your dog. It is not that hard to do.
