OPEN BURNING

To all residents of Delmar!

There have been reports of open burning within the city limits of Delmar. There is a fine for causing "Offensive smells & Air Pollution" within the city which carries fines up to \$100.00 under the Municipal Infraction Ordinance. There have been reports of burning of possible tires & toxic items being burned in open fire areas.

The only burning that can be done has to be in a burn barrel with a steel grate over the top to prevent ashes from becoming airborne.

Please be courteous of your neighbors and those with health issues within our city. If you are ever in question of what type of burning can be done please contact the local Fire Department or one of the Fire Department Volunteers.
